

ORGANIZED TOURS 2014

1. VOLCANO – HOT SPRINGS – THIRASSIA – SUNSET IN OIA (EVERY DAY)

The bus picks up clients from the designated pick up points and drives them to Athinios port, in order to embark on the traditional boat (caiique).

The first stop is at the islet of **NEA KAMENI**, which is the **VOLCANO** of Santorini. There, clients have the opportunity to climb to the crater of the still active, but dormant Volcano, 127 meters above the sea level, which last erupted in 1950.

After 1 ½ hour, the boat leaves the Volcano and heads to the small islet of **PALAIKA KAMENI** or **HOT SPRINGS**, as it is better known, which was formed through the centuries by several Volcanic eruptions. Along the coastline of the isle there are many hot springs, and clients have 30 minutes to swim in the warm yellow-green waters, which are considered to have healing powers.

The next stop is at **THIRASSIA**, the second largest island after Santorini in the Caldera. The island, located opposite of Santorini, and it is quiet and unaffected by the large numbers of tourist arriving every day. Here, clients will have 2 hours free time to explore the island, have lunch in one of the many small taverns, or swim in the crystal clear waters.

Finally, the boat departs from **THIRASSIA** and heads to the traditional port of Ammoudi, from where the clients take the stairs to **OIA** village (on foot or by donkeys). In **OIA**, clients can explore the traditional settlement, wander in the narrow streets, admire the unique architecture, blending

large Venetian houses and small cave homes, and of course watch the world famous sunset.

After the sunset, the buses will be waiting in the parking area to return clients to their hotels.

Official rate: **38.00€** per person

Not included in the rate: **2.00€** per person Volcano entrance fees + lunch in Thirassia

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2. VOLCANO – HOT SPRINGS – THIRASSIA (EVERY DAY)

The bus picks up clients from the designated pick up points and drives them to Athinios port, in order to embark on the traditional boat.

The first stop is at the isle of **NEA KAMENI**, also known as the **VOLCANO**. There, clients have the chance to climb to the crater of the Volcano, passing by many sulfur vents.

After 1 ½ hour, the boat leaves the Volcano and heads to the small islet of **PALAIKAMENI** or **HOT SPRINGS**, as it is called by the locals, formed by several Volcanic eruptions, with many hot springs along its coastline. There, clients have 30 minutes to swim in the warm yellow-green, from the sulfur, waters, considered to have healing powers.

The next stop is at **THIRASSIA**, the second largest island after Santorini in the Caldera. The island, located opposite of Santorini, is a contrast to it, quiet and undeveloped, untouched by tourism. Here, clients will have 2 hours free time to have lunch in one of the many small taverns, or swim in the crystal clear waters. Alternatively, they can walk or take a donkey ride to the top of the island and explore the capital, Manolas village.

Afterwards, the boat leaves **THIRASSIA** and, sailing along the coastline of Santorini, returns to Athinios port, where the buses will be waiting to take clients back to their hotels.

Official rate: **33.00€** per person

Not included in the rate: **2.00€** per person Volcano entrance fees + lunch in Thirassia

3. DINNER ON BOARD AFRODITI CAIQUE (EVERY DAY)



The bus picks up clients from the designated pick up points and drives them to Athinios port, in order to embark on the traditional boat **AFRODITI**.

The first stop is at the **VOLCANO**, as the isle of **NEA KAMENI** is better known. There, clients have the opportunity to climb to the crater of this dormant

Volcano.

1 ½ hour later, the boat leaves the Volcano and heads to the small islet of **PALAI A KAMENI**, otherwise known as **HOT SPRINGS**, where clients have 30 minutes to swim in the warm (35°C) waters, which are considered to have healing powers.



Next, the caique sails in the Caldera, and stops under the traditional village of **OIA**, where dinner on board accompanied by delicious Santorini wine is served, while clients enjoy the unique sunset view.

Hot springs

After the sunset the boat sails along the coastline of Santorini and returns to Athinios port, where the buses wait to take clients back to their hotels.

Official rate: **55.00€** per person

Not included in the rate: **2.00€** per person Volcano entrance fees
